Memorial

Memorial Day is tomorrow and many people will be off from work and several will be on vacation. I spotted a cartoon recently that showed a split screen. On one side a family was outside playing and grilling food and the dad said, "This is great! I wish every weekend was Memorial Weekend!" On the other side of the screen a mother and two children gazed at a service portrait of dad and a folded, framed flag. Their caption read, "For some families, it is."

The reality is that we often miss the point of what we experience. True, having a three-day weekend and spending more time with family is great. But do we even take the time to learn of the origin of the holiday and then teach it to our children? Most do not.

This article isn't about the history of Memorial Day. But for those who won't look it up, it started as a Decoration Day in 1868 as a time to decorate the graves of the soldiers who died serving our country. They gave their lives to protect and preserve our freedom, yet many will not even pause this weekend to think about their sacrifice.

How about as Christians? This morning's lesson, in our series on worship, is about worship in communion. The Lord's Supper is a memorial; a time for us to remember what Jesus has done for us. He gave His life for us so that we might enjoy everlasting life in Heaven.

Some are guilty at times of just "going through the motions" during worship, including the communion. Instead of remembering the sacrifice of Jesus, we find people texting, sorting through their things, talking or daydreaming. Jesus said as we partake of the bread and cup we should "do this in remembrance of Me" (1 Cor. 11:24-25). Paul concludes that section saying, "For as often as you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord's death till He comes" (1 Cor. 11:26).

Friends, let's not miss the point of worship. Let's renew our minds to the purpose and blessings of worship and teach our families and friends as well. Mike
