Do We Really Mean What We Say?

Sometimes we get so familiar with things we kind of take them for granted.

We say things without thinking about what we are saying or even what they mean.

Perhaps we even do this with Scripture. Recently, thinking about the 23rd Psalm, I realized what I was really reading. “The Lord is my Shepherd” sounds like a pretty simple statement, but it is really a “strong phrase.” When you think about all the promised blessings that follow (not having to worry about having things we need or the peace of “walking beside still waters” etc.), all these blessings are promised on the condition that “the Lord is really my Shepherd.”

When I say “the Lord is my Shepherd”—that means I am totally committed to Him. I have turned my life over to Him and I will do as He commands. When I do this, then I receive all the blessings listed in the psalm plus many others. It also makes life easier and less confusing. When others are trying to make decisions, mine are already made, because when I say “the Lord is my Shepherd,” I am going to do what He says. It makes no difference if the Super Bowl is on and it is at church time, I am going to worship (Hebrews 10:25). The same applies to many other things such as the way I dress (1 Timothy 2:9), the places I go or the movies I watch (1 Thessalonians 5:22), etc.

My decision was made when I obeyed the gospel and said “The Lord is my Shepherd.” It makes life more blessed, easier, and a lot more peaceful. “God is good.”

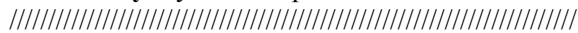
