Father's Day

Today is Father's Day and we wish to thank all fathers for doing all that you do in the family. Tonight's lesson will focus on some reasons why fathers are needed today.

Father's Day as a holiday was inspired by the establishment of Mother's Day. The first celebrations of Father's Day began in 1910, prompted by Sonora Dodd. She had heard a sermon on mothers the year before and asked her preacher if something could be done to honor fathers as well. In 1910 several ministers in Spokane, Washington, coordinated their sermons to focus on fathers.

The idea of a national celebration was presented to Congress in 1913, but it took decades until it was finally signed into law. Lyndon Johnson made a proclamation in 1966 designating the third Sunday in June as Father's Day. It was finally signed into law as a permanent holiday in 1972.

Fathers have always been important in God's plan for the family. Consider these passages concerning what a father should be doing for the family.

- •Provide for the family. Matt. 7:7-12.
- •Teach the children. Eph. 6:4; Prov. 22:6; Deut. 6:1-9.
- •Discipline. Heb. 12:5-12; Prov. 22:15.
- •Love. 1 John 4:7-11; Luke 15:11-24.

Fathers have a tremendous responsibility. "And you fathers, do not provoke your children to wrath, but bring them up in the training and admonition of the Lord" Eph. 6:4. We appreciate you, fathers! Keep up the good work! Our prayer is that every father can be successful in seeing his children as faithful Christians. Mike
