## Hebrews 10:25

*“Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is....”* We’ve heard it over and over. Many of us have the scripture memorized. And, most of us conclude from this passage that we simply should not miss the assembly. But, is that really what the writer of Hebrews is trying to convey to us? That we are simply to show up and punch our spiritual timecard?

A closer look at the preceding verse gives us a bit more insight into the writer’s intended context. *And let us consider one another to provoke unto love and to good works, not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another...* You see, the purpose stated is to “provoke, or build one another up.” We gather to build up each other, to encourage one another, to help our brothers and sisters stay on track. We assemble to cultivate our love for one another.

So, let’s refrain from robbing ourselves, and our family of this necessary spiritual nourishment. Let’s meet together at each opportunity. And, most importantly, let’s use that time to actively build up one another, exhort one another, and show brotherly love toward our spiritual family.

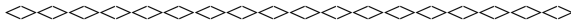

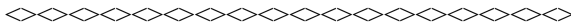

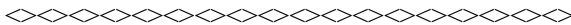


### 49ER'S GROUP
