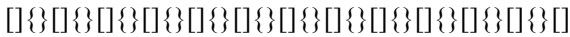

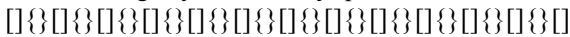
CONGRATULATIONS

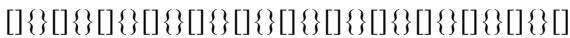
BULLETIN BOARDS/DOORS
