A Light to My Path

"Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path" Psalm 119:105.

From last week's sermon I mentioned that 88% of American households own a Bible and on average they have 4.7 copies of God's word. That's great news, but unfortunately, not everyone reads the Bible with frequency. That same source stated that only 37% read the Bible once or more a week.

Why is it so difficult for Christians to have a good routine for Bible reading? Unlike the days before printing presses when Bibles were literally chained to the pulpit, we have ready access to the Bible today. We live in an era where virtually every translation and version of the Bible can be accessed immediately and without charge via the Internet.

Could it be that the Bible intimidates some people? After all, there are 66 books, 1,189 chapters and 31,173 verses in the Bible. How can one be expected to read all of that?

Yes it can be overwhelming if looked at as a whole. But did you realize that the average person could read through the entire Bible in a year by reading it only 15 minutes a day? Perhaps what we lack is a good system, routine or thirst to help us get into more frequent Bible reading.

May I suggest Psalm 119 as a good starting point this week? Psalm 119 is the longest chapter in the Bible. It has 22 sections of 8 verses, with each section starting with the letters of the Hebrew alphabet in order. This chapter is focused on the excellencies of the word of God and speaks often of how important God's word is in life.

Read through this chapter and discover the benefits of reading the Bible. It will keep you from sin (v. 11), strengthen you (v. 28), guide your way (v. 105), bring you joy (v. 111), lead you to wisdom (v. 130), protect you from stumbling (v. 165) and bring you back to God (v. 176). If you have had trouble restarting your Bible reading habits, try reading this chapter once a day for a week. See if these inspired words will help light your path and encourage further reading of God's word! Mike
