Secretary Sonya Cox Title: "A Work of Art?"

What's the first image that pops into your mind when you read the words "the evolution of man"?

In 1965, the Time-Life Nature Library series included a book titled *Early Man* by F. Clark Howell. Howell – one of the fathers of paleoanthropology, which studies the fossil remains of humans – and his team of artists created a "work of art" that effectively sold an idea: that humans evolved from monkey-type creatures. Although Howell and the editors of the Time-Life series would admit the parade of creatures was made up, this picture, or one like it, is found in textbooks, spread across the Internet and sometimes even used as an ad campaign splattered on billboards. But does the fact that it shows up all over the place make it historically and scientifically correct?

With all the information floating around, consider some of the top fossil finds that scientists have used to make this connection.

Lucy – The three-feet-tall fossilized skeleton found by Don Johanson in Ethiopia in 1974. Originally thought to be the oldest ancestor of humans and apes. The truth is that Lucy's hips (which stick out to the side like an ape's) show she would not have been able to walk upright like humans. Her locking wrists are also very similar to animals that walk with their knuckles – for example, chimpanzees. Conclusion – she is a monkey.

Nebraska Man – An artist drew this character, his family, and their livestock all from a tooth discovered in the early 1920s. In 1927 it was discovered that the tooth was not from an ape-like ancestor, but rather from an extinct pig.

Neanderthal Man – First discovered in 1856 in a cave near Dusseldorf, Germany. The first conclusion drawn was that the remains were of humans; however, with Charles Darwin's writing, *On the Origin of Species* being published in 1859, the search began to discover the link between apes and men. After many examinations and false theories spreading, it was discovered these were the remains of humans who suffered from a bone diseases – rickets or arthritis – caused from a poor diet and lack of sunlight.

Of the entire collection of fossils that have been found, only about 0.1 percent are from animals with bones (vertebrates). Within this small amount, even fewer fossils could be traced to primates (humans, apes, monkeys, etc.). How is it, then, that Howell and his artists came to the conclusion that man and monkeys both evolved from a similar ancestor – Lucy? There's only one way – they read their belief of evolution into the fossils, and that's bad science.

When you look at the fossil record in light of what the Scriptures say – "Then God said, 'Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness; let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over the cattle, over all the earth and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth" (Genesis 1:26) – you begin to see that fossils don't go against the Word of God; rather, they confirm it.
