CANOE TRIP

There will be a canoe trip on Saturday, June 2nd. We will be leaving the church building at 7 am and should depart at 8 am from the canoe place. Everyone is asked to pay Cody and he will use the church credit card and pay for all at once, which will speed it up tremendously when you arrive. If we get enough people for 10 boats, the cost will be: \$35 per canoe; \$25 per kayak. If we don't get enough for 10 boats, the cost will be: \$40 per canoe; \$30 per kayak. Trip is 8 miles long from Factory to Iron City (It is the same one that was done last year). It should take 3-4 hours.
