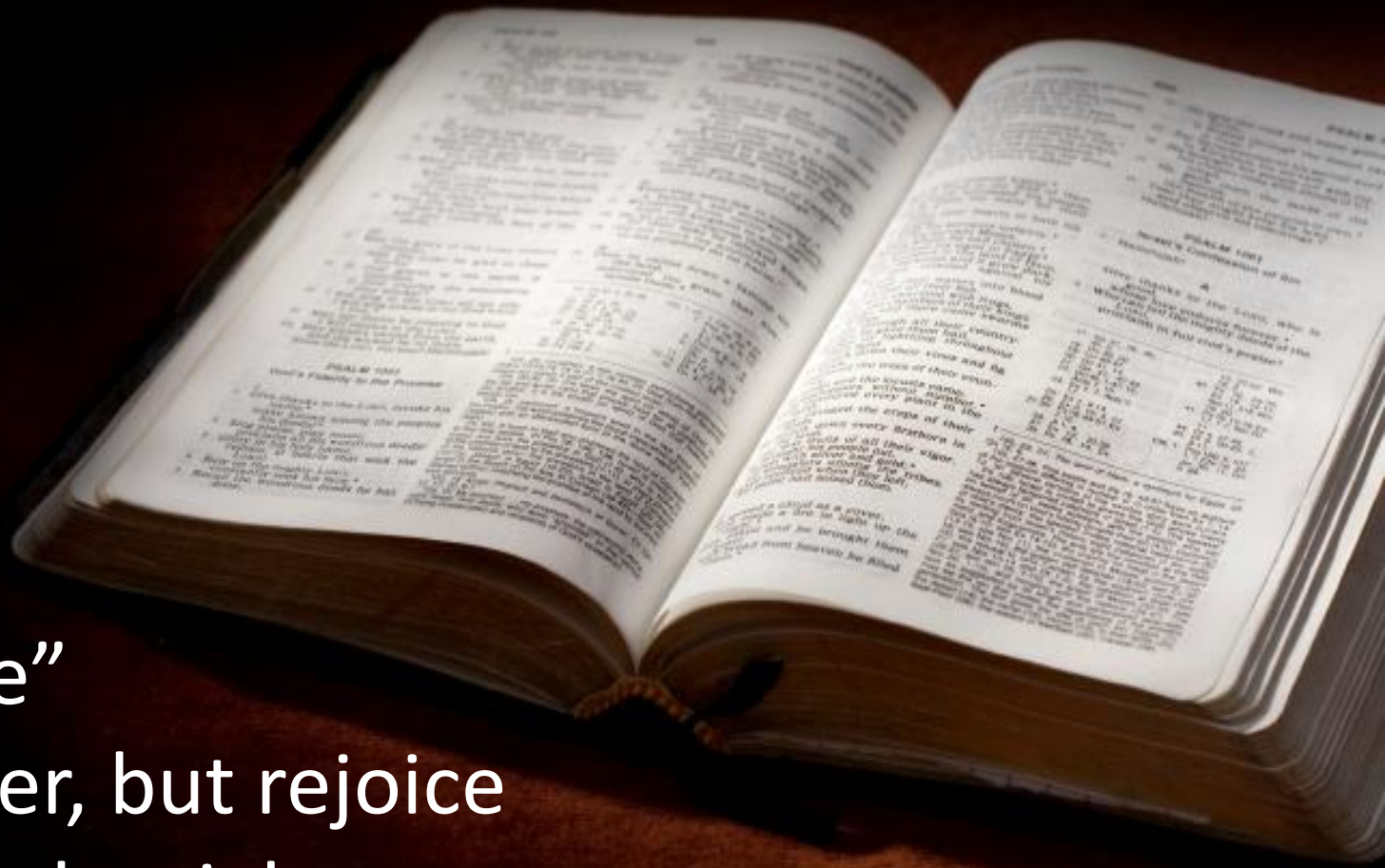

²⁷Now ²⁷you are the body of Christ and individually ²⁷members appointed in the church first ²⁷apostles, second ²⁷prophets, then ²⁷gifts of healing, ²⁷helping, ²⁷administrating, and ²⁷various other gifts. ²⁸Are all apostles? Are all prophets? Are all teachers? Do all possess gifts of healing? Do all speak with tongues? Do all desire the higher gifts. And I will show you a still more excellent way.

The Way of Love

If I speak in the tongues of men and of angels, but have not love, I am like a gong or a clanging cymbal. ²And if I have ²prophetic powers, but do not have love, I am like a bell that rings but has no sound. ³If I give away all I have, and ³if I surrender my body to be burned, but have not love, I gain nothing. ⁴Love is patient and ⁴kind; love ⁴does not envy or boast; it is not arrogant and ⁴is not proud; it does not do what it likes to do, it is not irritable or resentful; it does not rejoice when its enemy is wronged, but ⁴rejoices with the truth. ⁵Love bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, ⁵endures all things.

⁶Love never ends. As for prophecies, they will pass away; as for tongues, they will cease; as for knowledge, it will pass away. ⁷For we know in part and we prophesy in part, ⁷but ⁷when the perfect comes, the partial will pass away. ⁸When I was a child, I spoke like a child, I thought like a child, I reasoned like a child. When I became a man, I gave up childish ways. ⁹For ⁹now we see in a mirror, dimly, but then we will see face to face. Now I know in part; then I shall know fully even as I have fully known. Now faith, hope, and love abide, these three; but the greatest of these is love.

Prophecy and Tongues
