- Tradition holds that Micah prophesied for 20-55 years during the 8th century BC.
- Micah prophesied to the common people concerning the depravity of the nation following the Assyrian invasion in 701 BC
 (2 Kings 18: 13)



- Name means -"Who is like Yahweh?"
- Probably lived as a yeoman, farming his own plot of land.
- Moresheth is located about 25 miles SW of Jerusalem.
- At the same time, Isaiah is prophesying in Jerusalem.
- Micah is the first prophet to threaten Judah with the destruction of Jerusalem.
