Descendant of Aaron. (7:1-5)


Priest & Scribe. (7:6, 21)

Babylon took control over Judah from 597–582 BC.

Nebuchadnezzar, king of Babylon, deported Judean citizens
3x: 597, 586 (after fall of Jerusalem in 587), and 582.

Ezra brings people back to Judah, from Babylon, in 453 BC.
