

Descendant of Aaron. (7:1-5)

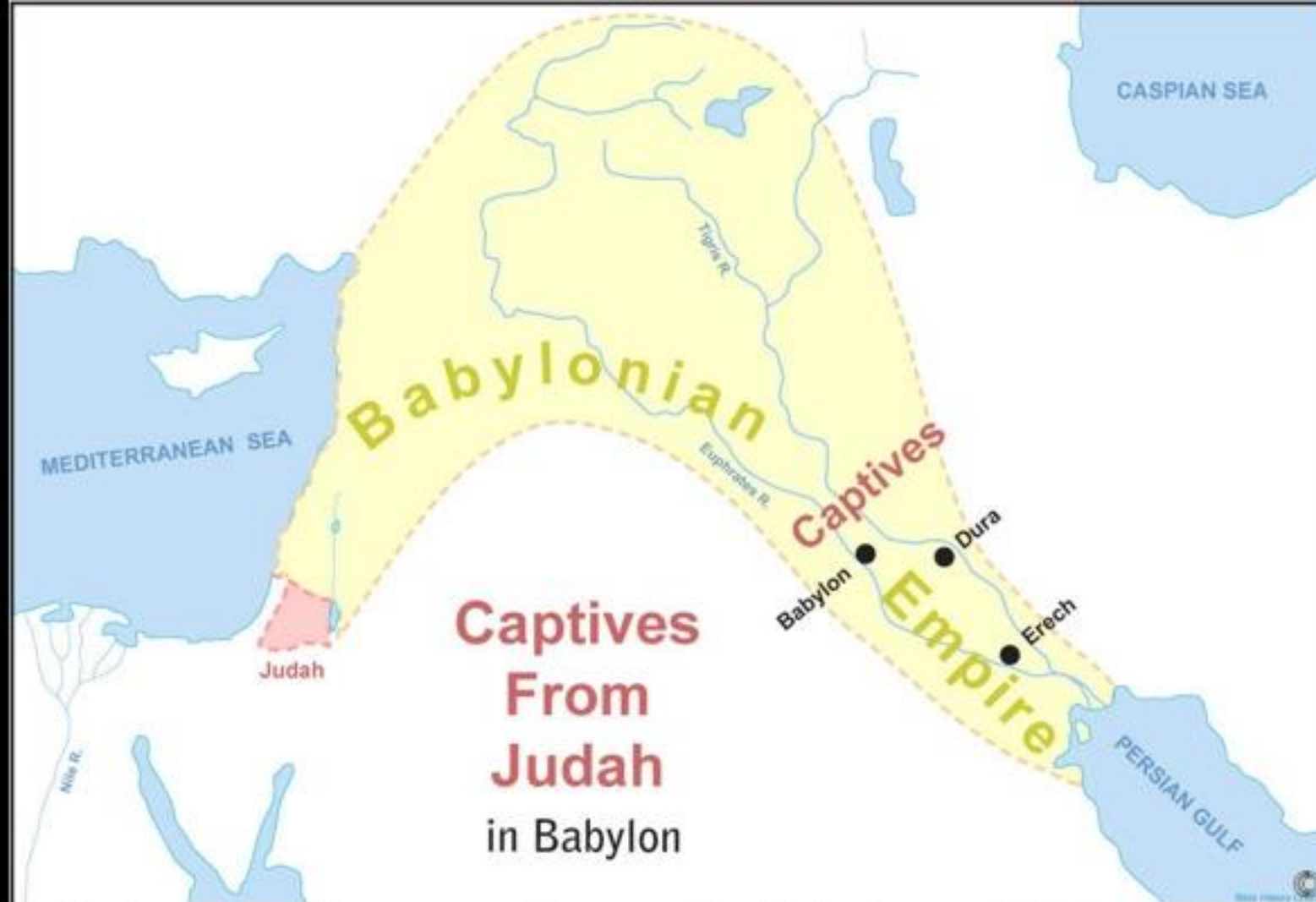
Priest & Scribe. (7:6, 21)

Name means Helper.


Sincere & Zealous. (7:10; 8:21-23)

Deeply grieved over sins of people. (10:2, 3)




Babylon took control over Judah from 597–582 BC.
Nebuchadnezzar, king of Babylon, deported Judean citizens
3x: 597, 586 (*after fall of Jerusalem in 587*), and 582.
Ezra brings people back to Judah, from Babylon, in 453 BC.


