Virtual Reality Check

Christians want to be realistic in every area of life—to see things as they really are (*John 8:32*). As we do so, we are "taking every thought captive to the obedience of Christ" (*2 Corinthians 10:5*) and making our whole life a "living sacrifice" (*Romans 12:1–2*). The Bible teaches us that the most important realities of life are spiritual (God, heaven, everlasting life or death, etc.), and that our values in every area of life must be set in accordance with these most important realities.

Part of our reality is our experience with interactive, electronic technologies. Our recent disruption of life has thrust more and more people into the depths and crevasses of the internet. While the internet, social media, and web-based programs can be expedients for God's glory, they could also wreak havoc in our lives! So, let's take stock of how they may be affecting us, and make adjustments in order to glorify our Lord. Here are six probing, biblically based questions to help us with our "Virtual Reality Check":

- 1. Are there specific ways in which I am using electronic technology to promote directly the kingdom of God? *Matthew 6:33; Acts 19:8*
- 2. Am I addicted to electronic technology? 1 Corinthians 6:12; 2 Corinthians 6:14
- 3. Is the amount of time I spend on electronic technology hindering my service to the Lord? *Ephesians 5:15-16; Colossians 4:5*
- 4. Is my use of electronic technology weakening my ability to study the Bible or listen to the Word being preached? Luke 8:18; Acts 17:3-4, 11
- 5. Is my experience with electronic technology leading me to impurity of thought? *Matthew 5:27-30; Philippians 4:8*
- 6. How is my use of electronic technology affecting my assessment of myself? Have I developed too low or too high an opinion of myself? Galatians 2:20; 1 Timothy 3:6

It would be a tragedy to be lost due to abuse of technology. We cannot give the devil a foothold into our lives! If Jesus analyzed my usage of electronic devices, would He be pleased or disappointed? Let's resolve to use all of our physical blessings, including technology, to the glory of God. Let's grow in grace and knowledge of our Lord and where necessary, make adjustments—even sacrificial ones (2 Peter 3:18).
