





The salvation of humanity is dependent on God's grace and is not the result of human work or effort (***Ephesians 2:8-9***). Rather, our good work and good conduct is our way of pleasing God and is the recognition and result of His grace to us (***2 Corinthians 5:8-9; 1 John 4:19***). Each person may receive the salvation God offers by repentance and faith in Jesus expressed through baptism in his name (***Acts 2:38; Acts 22:16; Romans 6:1-7; Galatians 3:27; 1 Peter 3:21***). Those who faithfully follow and are obedient to Christ are promised eternal life in Him (***1 John 1:7; Revelation 2:10***).
