Biblical Doctrines: HEAR

Will someone call on the name of the Lord if they do not believe? Will someone believe in the Lord if they have not heard of the Lord? How will someone hear about the Lord if no one chooses to tell them about the Lord (*Romans 10:14*)? If these things are so, the simple answer is—the odds are not in their favor. A story is told about a man who came out of his house on his way to worship on Sunday morning, just as his neighbor came out of his house with his golf clubs. After a moment's silence, the golfer quietly said, "You know, Henry, I have often wondered about your church, and I have admired your faithful attendance. The need for God's people to share Jesus with others is paramount within each generation. The act is simple, but the follow-through seems to be quite the challenge. Let's just keep it simple. Answer these questions for yourself and you will be prepared to share Jesus with someone else. When did you become a Christian and what led to that decision? Was there a time in your life when God pricked your heart in a convicting way that changed you will remember forever? Now go, with those answers, and share Jesus this week!




