2 Weeks—1 Test

What in the world do I mean by the title “2 Weeks—1 Test”? Over the next two weeks we will challenge ourselves with the same challenge that Jesus was given in the form of a test; Matthew 22:35-36. Jesus’ response was 2 parts of awesome, love God and love others. His love passed the test with flying colors. The test question for us to consider is, if our love for God and others were put to the test, would we pass? The test question and first part of Jesus’ response is:

Which Is The Greatest Commandment?

*“You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart
and with all your soul and with all your mind.”*

Jesus loved his Father so much that he was willing to sacrifice his wants and desires to be pleasing to God. Sometimes loving God meant late nights (*John 3:1-20*). Sometimes loving God meant early mornings (*Mark 1:35*). Sometimes loving God meant waiting for the right moment (*John 4:46-50*). Sometimes loving God meant acting lovingly (*Luke 23:34*). Sometimes loving God meant acting confrontationally (*Mark 14:26-31*). Simply put, loving God like Jesus did is an all-the-time type of life.

There is nothing more important in this life than an individual choosing daily to love God with all of their heart, soul and mind. I hope that above all things, Brianne and I have lived among you as individuals who love God more than anything else and have encouraged others to do the same. But holistic love for God is not always easy. This type of love will challenge us on a daily basis. This type of love will require us letting go of some things we hold near and dear. This type of love will demand 100% from each individual. And...this type of love will reward 100% of those transformed by it.

I don’t want to scare, intimidate or push anyone away with my strong language. I simply want to encourage each individual to love God with all of their heart, soul and mind. Will your love for God pass the test? And a second is like it...(next week)

We also express our sympathy to Beth Jordan and her family, in the passing away of her mother, Virginia McCaleb. Her funeral was conducted yesterday.


