The End

No matter what an individual does, they cannot cheat death. The fact of the matter is every person is destined to experience death unless Christ makes his second coming. Unless Christ returns in one's lifetime, each person will experience a bodily resurrection from death and God's judgment which will determine their eternal fate (<u>John 5:28-29</u>; <u>Hebrews 9:27</u>). Having rejected God, unbelievers and the disobedient, will suffer eternal separation from God in hell (<u>Matthew 13:41-42</u>; <u>2 Thessalonians 1:5-9</u>). Faithful and obedient believers will be received into joyful communion with God in heaven (<u>John 14:1-6</u>). These are facts of life from Scripture that serve as realities for us to hear and be prepared for.

The Choice

In order to be prepared, all persons who have submitted their lives to the Lordship of Christ are united with him and with His body, His church. A person who submits is one who hears (understands), believes (has faith), repents (changes to please God), confesses (makes known) Jesus as the Son of God, and then is baptized by being immersed in water (Acts 2:37-38; Acts 8:26-39; Acts 16:11-15; Acts 16:25-34). God then adds them to Christ's body, the one church (Acts 2:47; Ephesians 4:4-6; Colossians 1:18). Scripture teaches many principles which can only be understood and followed when a person is a believing member of a local congregation of Christ's church.

The Church

Believers in local congregations of Christ's church are to gather for worship, prayer, fellowship and the study of the Word (<u>Acts 2:42; Hebrews 10:24-25</u>). The local congregation is the place where each person's faith is developed, their gifts used in service, and where believers work together to reach those who have not heard the message of Jesus (<u>1 Corinthians 12:12-27</u>). Led and fed by elders (shepherds or pastors), deacons, and ministers, members are to work in unity and love for the ultimate purpose of glorifying and obeying God and Jesus Christ. However, there are matters that must be handled within the local congregation that may not be specifically discussed in Scripture. Therefore, in all matters of faith and practice, Scripture is the final authority. In essential matters of faith, the church should be unified. In matters of opinion, members have freedom to follow their consciences (*I would also suggest that they be communicating with the spiritual leaders, the Shepherds, for guidance and prayer*). In all matters of belief, love and respect should be shown within the church.
