"Go Deep!!!"

If you've ever played a game of pickup football then you already know that it's very different than an actual game of football. Quarterbacks in "pickup" games don't step into huddles and say "Jet right, slot right, curl, 52 post on two, ready... BREAK!" Now you can get pretty creative and it starts out well intentioned enough. You can draw up reverses, halfback passes, slants, flags, curls, and dig routes right there in the dirt. But after a bunch of incompletions, miscommunication, interceptions and accusations you eventually get to the point where you just look at the confused faces and say "Everybody just Go Deep!"

Now, that normally doesn't work in real football at any level. Yet, spiritually it should be the goal of every Christian to just go deep. Though certainly a new Christian must begin with the milk of the word (1 Peter 2:2), that is only the foundation of what a stronger faith with knowledge and wisdom are built upon. The Bible is God's treasure trove of wonderful riches (Ephesians 3:8) that we are to deposit in our hearts. And failing to go deep in study of scripture is to rob your own soul and by extension the soul of your family and those that you love. In fact, it isn't hard to see a child of God that lacks knowledge of the word and an understanding of its concepts and principles not to mention the application of its wealth and wisdom. They stand out. They look like a fan, not a player.

It is truly disheartening to hear the Lord's people talk in a shallow way about the deep edicts of God. Troubling to watch them elevate tradition and opinion in place of His commandments. Devastating to see them make decisions based on a worldly criterion. All these failures come from a refusal to "go deep" into God's word. That's a shame. The Lord's church desperately needs Christians with depth.

God's word starts out with these words in *Genesis chapter 1 and verse 1*: "In the beginning..." And in this beginning of a new year and a new reading program resolve yourself Christian to not only read, but get deep into God's word. For He needs people who will do more than read. They will share. More than share, they will explain. More than explain, they will instill. More than instill, they will show you just how deep they can go with the truth of God's word.

Now everybody, GO DEEP! Ready, BREAK!


