## 5 Types of Offerings at the Tabernacle

	Frequency	Purpose
<b>Burnt offerings</b> <i>Leviticus 1</i>	2x/day, at morning and twilight - <i>Exodus 29:38-42; Numbers 28:3, 6</i> Each Sabbath day Fire doesn't go out - <i>Numbers 28:9-10</i> - <i>Lev 6:9-13</i> Beginning of Each Month - <i>Numbers 28:11</i> During Feasts - <i>Numbers 28-29</i>	Complete dedication of the worshiper ( <i>Romans 12:1-2</i> )
<b>Meal offerings</b> <i>(cereal, meat in KJV)</i>	Every time an offering used fire - <i>Numbers 15:4, 11, 12</i>	Thanksgiving to God for the necessities of life ( <i>Matthew 6:11</i> )
<b>Peace offerings</b>	Potentially, daily - <i>Leviticus 6:12-13</i> Thanksgiving - <i>Leviticus 7:12-15</i> Completion of a Vow OR Freewill - <i>Leviticus 7:16-18</i>	Peace in relationship with God. All things are in good standing
<b>Sin offerings</b>	As necessary (unintentional) - <i>Leviticus 4:2-12</i> → if the High Priest sins - <i>Leviticus 4:13-21</i> → Nation of Israel sins - <i>Leviticus 4:22-26</i> → a leader sins - <i>Leviticus 4:27-31</i> → common person sins No sacrifice intentional sins ( <i>Numbers 15:30-31</i> )	To: 1) Remove consequences of sin 2) Be Reconciled to God *Jesus is only source of true forgiveness
<b>Guilt offerings</b> <i>(Trespass)</i>	As necessary (unintentional) - <i>Leviticus 5:14-6:17</i>	Guilt of the individual who misappropriated that which belonged to God or someone else.

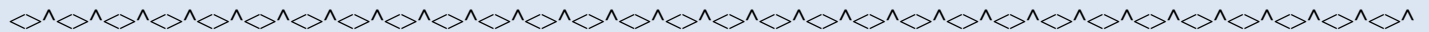

**SYMPATHY**

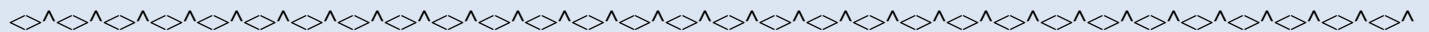
We express our sympathy to DeeDee McManus and her family in the passing away of her mother, Gloria Bouldoc. A memorial service will be held at a later date.

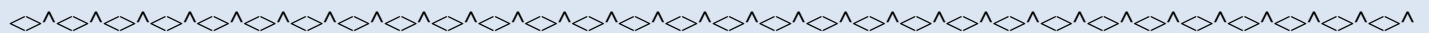
**BABY GIRL DIAPER POUNDING**

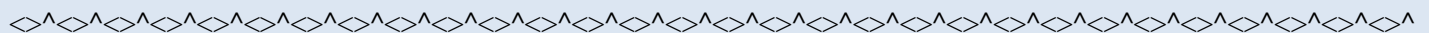
**BABY BOY SHOWER**
