Secretary Sonya Cox As we read through the Scriptures, and especially in books like the Chronicles, it's easy to miss some of the life-altering lessons if we aren't careful. I find myself sometimes reading these books in the Bible, and thinking, "ok, we got it...God chose Israel, they sinned over and over, God forgave them over and over, and then He finally got fed up with their disobedience, and destroyed them...the end!" The lesson I take away is that God chose us as His people. We sin over and over, and He forgives us, but eventually He will get fed up with our disobedience, and we will suffer eternally if we don't repent. While that is a lesson we should learn from the examples we read about in the Chronicles, and other Old Testament books, it isn't the ONLY lesson we should learn.

Ecclesiastes 1:9 says "That which has been is what will be, that which is done is what will be done, and there is nothing new under the sun." Romans 15:4 says "For whatever things were written before were written for our learning, that we through the patience and comfort of the Scriptures might have hope." It doesn't say "through the patience and comfort of the Scriptures, except for most of Leviticus, Deuteronomy, the Chronicles, etc....." There is power in God's Word...ALL of it! During our reading in the coming weeks, I would challenge all of us to truly seek out the "little lessons" being taught by our Most High God (El Elyon), Our Creator (Elohim), The Eternal God (El Olam), The God who sees (El Roi), Almighty God (El Shaddai), and as He told Moses, The Great I AM (Yahweh). I believe there is a lesson right there in how many different ways God chose to describe Himself to His people. Never underestimate the value of the privilege we have in being able to read the Word of God. Savor every word of it!
