Jeremiah

Interesting Facts about Jeremiah

- Wrote Jeremiah and Lamentations
- Contemporary prophet with Zephaniah, Habakkuk, Ezekiel, Daniel.
- Prophesied about 40 years, some thinking that he began around age 20!
- Prophesied under Josiah and his sons from the year 626-587 BC (Jeremiah
- Babylon came and enslaved Israel during his prophetic tenure (587 BC).
- He prophesied repentance, and if not, judgement. He was rarely listened to, probably disliked, ignored, and imprisoned by his own people for speaking God's word.

Profound Prophecy of the New Covenant

Jeremiah 31:31-34:

³¹ "Behold, the days are coming, declares the LORD, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and the house of Judah, ³² not like the covenant that I made with their fathers on the day when I took them by the hand to bring them out of the land of Egypt, my covenant that they broke, though I was their husband, declares the LORD. 33 For this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, declares the LORD: I will put my law within them, and I will write it on their hearts. And I will be their God, and they shall be my people. ³⁴ And no longer shall each one teach his neighbor and each his brother, saying, 'Know the LORD,' for they shall all know me, from the least of them to the greatest, declares the LORD. For I will forgive their iniquity, and I will remember their sin no more."

Hebrews 8:6 says, "But as it is, Christ has obtained a ministry that is as much more excellent than the old as the covenant he mediates is better, since it is enacted on better promises."

What are the better promises?

- God's New Covenant is based on Jesus Christ.
- God's New Covenant consists of true forgiveness and redemption.
- God's New Covenant does not require travel to the temple for worship to God. He is with us and we are with Him. His people are scattered all throughout the world, serving, gathering, worshiping, and evangelizing.
